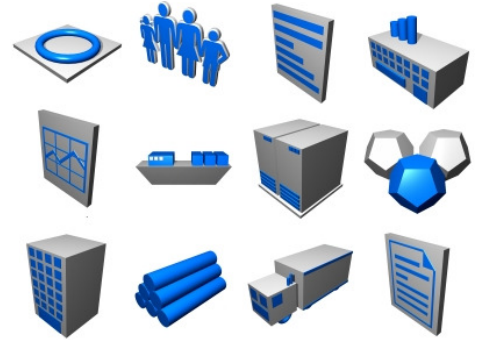

CASE STUDY

A fresh foods distributor had outgrown their warehouse space and wanted to size a new warehouse to allow further growth. We started the work but our analysis showed that 20% of stock was redundant and a further 20% was slow moving. Analysis showed that the reasons behind this were inefficient processes, an outdated and ineffective IT system, and inefficient use of storage space. We revised the strategy and implemented our recommendations which:

- avoided the cost of a larger warehouse and the disruption of relocating
- grew the business a further 25% using the existing space and staffing levels
- improved operational efficiency and its processes
- released the value of the inactive stock back into the business

The financial benefits were significant and the client was well placed to continue sales growth.
